



SPEAK-EASY™ PAGING SYSTEM

Your Speak Easy(tm) has been designed to provide paging capabilities to restaurants, clubs and bars that are using standard consumer stereo systems. After following the simple connection diagram and directions, a push of the TALK button will allow paging over the existing system without major inconveniences. A dynamic microphone with the feature of a lock on switch must be used to allow the message to be broadcasted with ease. The unit has two control knobs that provide adjustment to the volume level (OUTPUT) and the microphone sensitivity (GAIN).

INSTALLATION:

1. Place the unit in a convenient location and near the microphone.
2. Connect the wires according to the diagram on the reverse side of this page. Be sure to connect the red plugs to the red jack and the black plugs to the black jacks.
3. The EXTRA IN jacks are for use with optional equipment such as an CD Player, Muzak(tm)* system, Direct Satellite(tm)* system or a 3M Satellite(tm)* set up.
4. After all the connections have been made and the unit as been plugged into a wall socket, a test can be performed and adjustment can be made to the GAIN and OUTPUT knobs to suit your tastes.
5. The EXTRA switch on the front of the unit allows a choice of sound sources, either from the tape or the optional equipment source.

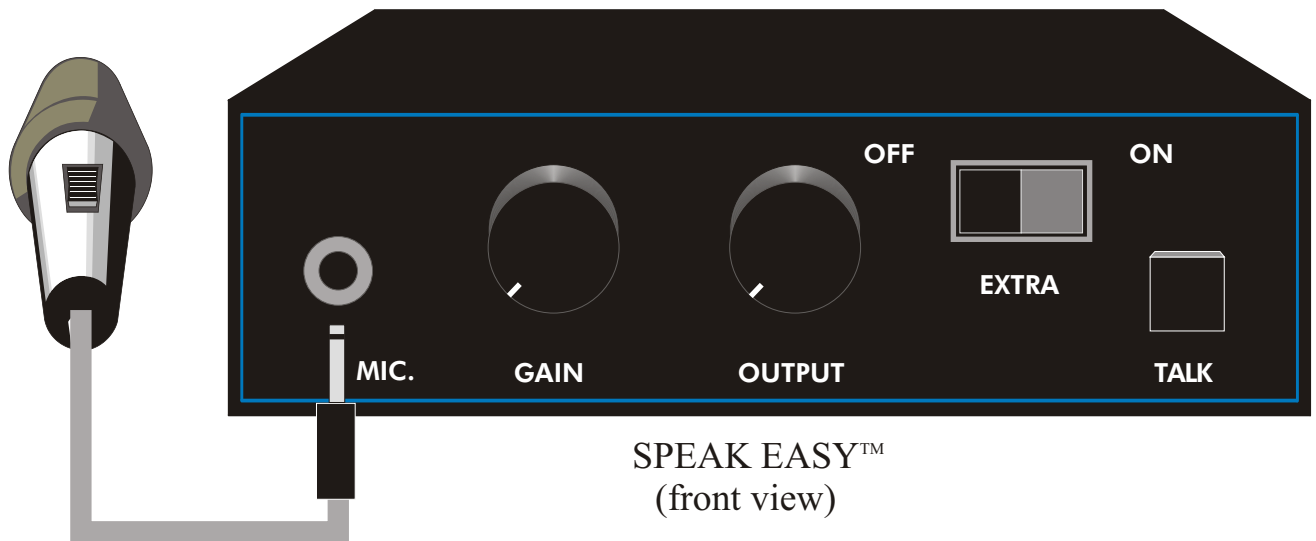
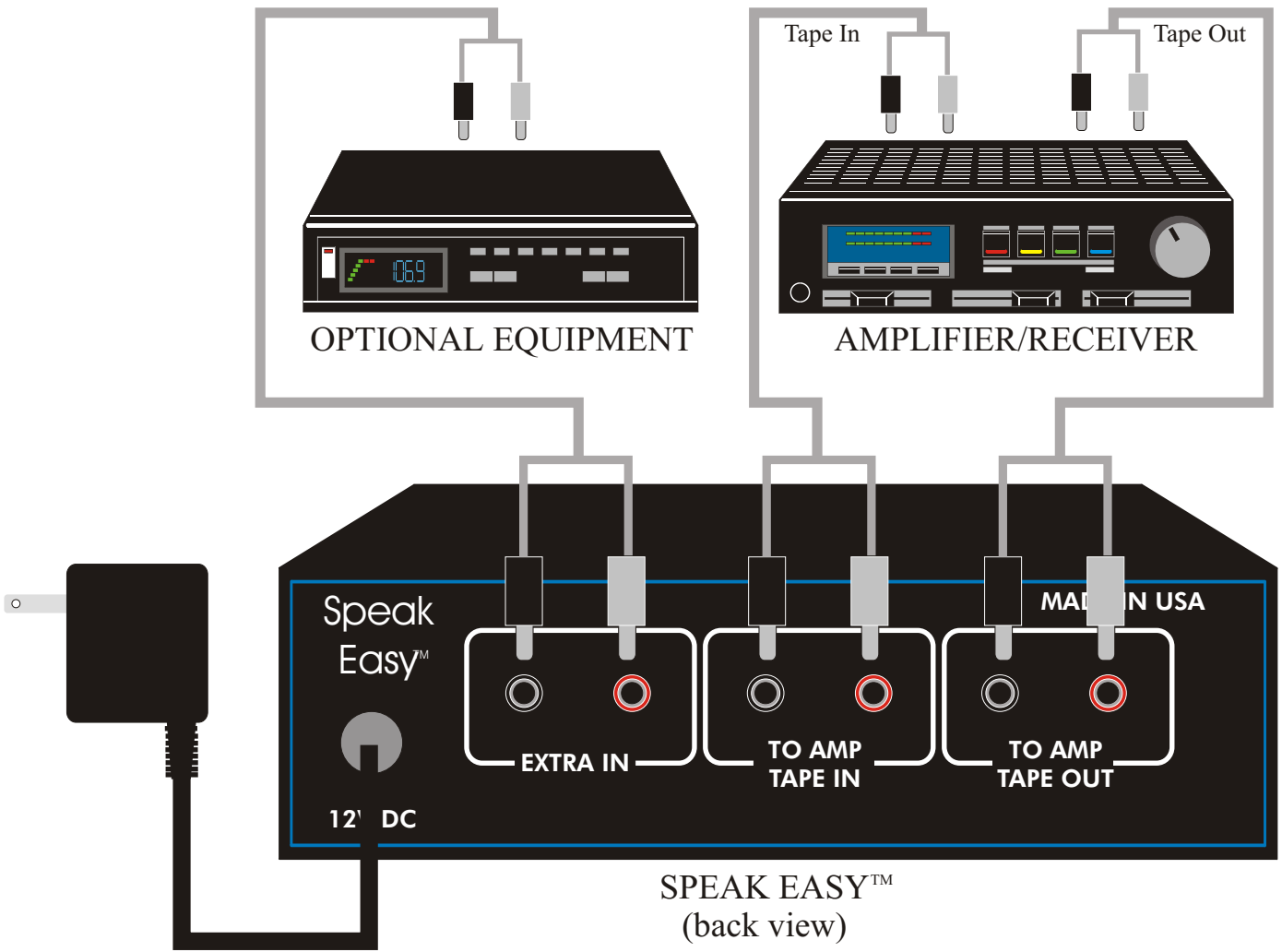
WARRANTY:
