S-VHS QUICK CONNECT

SPECIFICATIONS

Front Connector: S-VHS Connector
Rear Quick Connector Types: RCA Connector
F (COAX) Connector
Screw Down Connector

Your S-VHS Quick Connect speeds the job of transitioning S-VHS video runs with the option of three termination styles: RCA, F (COAX) or Screw Down Connectors. These termination options eliminate the need to solder Luminance and Chrominance conductors to the plate.

Wire Recommendations:

RCA Cables:

High quality, video compatible, thoroughly shielded and appropriately UL and CSA rated for in-wall use.

F (COAX) Cable:

If using RG-6, a solid copper center conductor is recommended. DO NOT USE copper clad steel wire (CCS) as this will result in higher than expected signal loss.

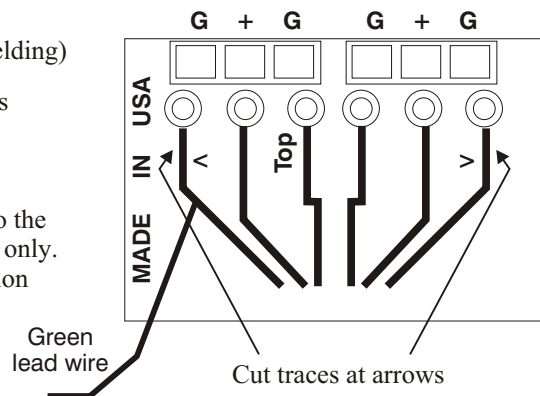
Video Compatible Communication Cable:

High quality, video compatible, thoroughly shielded and appropriately UL and CSA rated for in-wall use. DO NOT USE speaker wire, Zip cable, etc.

Building Ground Lead: (A metal box is recommended to enhance shielding)

Video hum bars due to equipment plugged into different AC circuit runs may be alleviated by tying one of the S-VHS plates to building ground.

On only ONE of the S-VHS plates, cut the electrical traces (two traces) indicated by the "<" mark on the PC board. Tie the GREEN lead wire to the metal electrical box that the S-VHS plate is mounted on in one location only. Because of the wide variety of building wiring situations, experimentation may be necessary to eliminate any interference.
