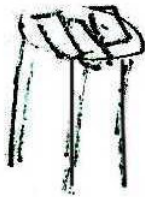


Back in 1969, we just had a TV, color if we were lucky. If you wanted to change channels, you got up.

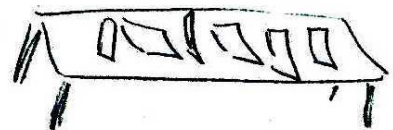
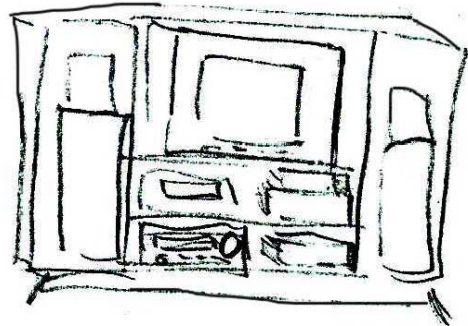
In 1979, we had a console with remote control, and maybe a cable box. There were two remotes on our coffee table.
